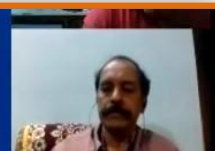

REPORT

KBN College had organized a conference on “Impact of Best Practices in Quality Enhancement in Higher Education Institutions” sponsored by NAAC (National Assessment & Accreditation Council), Bangalore in collaboration with APSCHE (Andhra Pradesh State Higher Education) on 4th & 5th December, 2020. The IQAC of KBN College took initiative to organize this event both in ONLINE and OFFLINE. The inaugural ceremony was held on Friday 4th December, 2020 at 9.30 am under the chairmanship of Sri. E. Varaprasad, Principal, KBN College.

Principal, welcomed the honorable guest and participants with introductory remarks. He thanked the NAAC, Bangalore for sponsoring this conference and also APSCHE for their collaboration and support. He also thanked the IQAC of KBN College for organizing a conference on this topic. The chief guest for the inaugural and the keynote speaker was Prof. K. Rama Mohana Rao, Vice-Chairman, APSCHE. The theme of the conference was presented by the IQAC Coordinator Dr. P. Bharathi Devi. She briefed the need and objective of organizing the conference in her theme. The Chief Guest in his delivery mentioned that there is a rapid change in the new education policy.

Which APSCHE had adopted and implemented the features in the educational institutions. He also insisted the importance of introduction of skill-oriented courses in the new curriculum by the APSCHE. The inaugural session ended with a formal vote of thanks. The keynote address followed by an inaugural session started at 10.15 am.

[Keynote Address – Prof. K. Rama Mohana Rao](#)

In his keynote address the resource person explained about various learning resources used to enhance the knowledge in their subjects to the teachers. He advised teachers to try to read other discipline subjects apart from their discipline. He suggested that a teacher should utilize all the infrastructural support provided them to improve their professional skills. He opined that it is the responsibility of a teacher to bring to the notice of the management to provide the infrastructure which is really necessary to upgrade their knowledge skills. As a teacher he/she shall continuously collect the feedback from the students to assess themselves. Self-assessment is mandatory to improve their teaching methodologies. He stressed on active research which is mandatory to the teacher and involvement of students.

[Day-I – 4.12.2020 - Technical Session-I – Dr. V. Subhashini](#)

The Technical Session I chaired by Dr. V. Subhashini, Retd. Head, Department of Zoology, KBN College. She explained about NAAC, Why it is mandatory for every college to go for assessment, the benefits of Accreditation, eligibility criteria to apply for NAAC. She gave a detailed explanation about the online process of applying for assessment by a college. She gave some guidelines on institutional preparation for quality enhancement like organizing seminars in all colleges for students through student's councils to get feedback from the students regarding the academic activities of the departments & college and any other student problems. She also mentioned that the internal audit should be done monthly. Every college must adopt 2 or 3 villages under NSS activity. Collection of feedback from the stakeholder is also mandatory to improve the quality enhancement. Finally, the session ended with the presentations by the participants. She concluded the session with a quote... Quality is a journey, not a destination. She answered to the queries patiently posed by the participants.

Technical Session-II – Dr. P. Krishna Murthy

The technical Session II handled by Dr. P. Krishna Murthy, Former Principal, KBN College addressed the gathering on Changing Trends in Higher Educational Institutions. Higher education imparts in-depth knowledge and understanding so as to advance the students to new frontiers of knowledge in different walks of life. It is about knowing more and more about less and less. It develops the student's ability to question and seek truth and makes him/her competent to critique on contemporary issues. Higher education is the production of qualified human resources. In this view, higher education is seen as a process in which the students are counted as "products" absorbed in the labour market. Thus, higher education becomes input to the growth and development of business and industry. Higher education is training for a research career.

In this view, higher education is preparation for qualified scientists and researchers who would continuously develop the frontiers of knowledge. Quality within this viewpoint is more about research publications and transmission of the academic rigor to do quality research. Higher education is the efficient management of teaching provision. Many strongly believe that teaching is the core of educational institutions. Thus, higher education institutions focus on efficient management of teaching-learning provisions by improving the quality of teaching, enabling a higher completion rate among the students. Technical Session-III – Dr.V.Narayana Rao

The final technical session III of Day 1 was handled by Dr. V. Narayana Rao, Former Principal, KBN College on Methodology of Teaching & Evaluation Process in Higher Education. Evaluation of teaching practices needs to be a part of every teaching process. Evaluation may be summative or formative. Summative evaluation investigates the overall efficiency of a program, policy or product, in order to decide on its sustainability. Formative evaluation is the realization of

teaching which is continuously assessed in order to make it richer and better.

He emphasized the changes occurred in the new education policy. The assessment must be designed with learner attributes in mind. These attributes, which have clear linkages to Program Education Objectives and Outcomes, stem from the taxonomy. A wide range of assessment types for evaluating students is available for the teachers/institutions to use. Each assessment type has its distinct utility, advantages and limitations. A suitable compendium of such types needs to be carefully chosen for a particular program depending on its nature, objectives and available resources.

Day – II – 05.12.2020 - Technical Session-IV – Dr. P.Anil Kumar

Second day started with the technical session IV handled by Dr. P. Anil Kumar, Academic Officer from CCE explained about the role and functionalities of IQAC and also the importance of maintaining quality circle. In his speech, he mentioned the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore proposes that every accredited institute should establish an Internal Quality Assurance Cell(IQAC) as a sustenance measure. The IQAC will become a part of the institution system and work towards realization of goals of quality enhancement and sustenance.

He explained the importance of IQAC in every college and also implement methodologies for development and application of quality parameters in various activities of the institution, dissemination of information on Quality Aspects, organization of workshops, seminars and promotion of quality circles, recording and monitoring quality measures of the institution, acting as an agency of the institution for quality related activities and preparation of annual quality reports. IQAC is also promoting the culture of quality measures and sustenance. It must act as a centralized unit and assess the internal quality and improve the quality of the organization. He stated that the members who are involved in the composition of IQAC under the Head of the Institution as a chairperson. Benchmarking is an ongoing systematic means for measuring and comparing the work processes of an

organization. The scene for benchmarking can be set, by considering three fundamental performance issues articulated by the FAQs.

Technical Session-V – Dr. M.Babu Reddy

The immediate technical session V was by Dr. M. Babu Reddy, Krishna University, was on Role of IQAC in Quality Sustenance & Enhancement in Higher education. He explained various teaching methods suitable for 21st century like flipped classroom, design thinking, thinking based learning, competency-based learning, etc., He explained the importance of quality of higher education in present society. If you don't maintain quality in every aspect that will leaves a negative impact on society. He also said any mistake committed in quality of education creates disturbances in the society. The basic purpose of any institute is to initiate, plan and supervise various activities connected to quality improvement. He also explained the importance of model institutions for providing quality education to students. He mentioned how American & European education system maintains quality in higher education. They give importance to practical exposure which is more important than classroom education for the students.

Feedback mechanism should be implemented in colleges for improving quality in higher educational institutions. He addressed the gathering regarding the quality successive cycle & its impact in quality in higher education. Every faculty should improve their quality bar which will improve students' quality, when student quality improves, exam results will be good. Students achieve good placement which is a sign of Quality and this attracts a qualitative entry of students into the institution. The role of IQAC is very crucial for improving quality in higher education. Credibility evaluation system is also one of the most important tools for quality in higher education. The IQAC & college management should implement effective credibility education system for their institutions. Learner centric academic environment is also one of the important tools for improving quality in higher education. Alumni feedback and Industrial needs feedback also helps to improve quality in higher education.

Technical Session-VI – Sri Mathew Srirangam

Sri Mathew Srirangam started his lecture with a Question Tag- “Do colleges (or) Higher Educational Institutions Really Changed?”. He, then continued with Defining Innovation, its types with few examples. Bench Mark, Changes in the Ecosystem of Higher Educational system mainly during this Pandemic Situation. He also compared higher Education as a Business and Students as Customers and the quality measures needed to improve the Knowledge of students, Innovative standards in preparation of Curriculum and by adding Self based and Learning based courses and also their availability in Online. He gave best information regarding Innovative Practices in Learning Outcomes and Competency based education, Innovations in Pedagogy methodology, Attentive Association between a Teacher and Students while engaging Students in an Online Class, changes in Evaluation, few modifications while framing the Syllabus. He explained about various pedagogy techniques, Best practices in quality enhancement and extension activities to enhance the skill set of the student. He also explained various reforms used in the evaluation process. He stressed that Sustaining Innovation is a process, system or modification that improves an existing product or system. It may make it better, bigger, more efficient and/or more beneficial to the end user. An example of sustaining innovation is a new, updated model of a car that gets better gas mileage. He further explained about the open curriculum like MIT’s Open Courseware, has been out for years but hasn’t disrupted much. He concluded with a quote “Don’t fix to a Problem that is NOT THERE”, rather come out of such mind set.

Finally, the Conference ended with valedictory session. The Chief Guest for this valedictory was Sri Mathew Srirangam, Academic Officer, APSCHE. He mentioned in his speech students must adopt outcome based education and think about the learning outcomes.



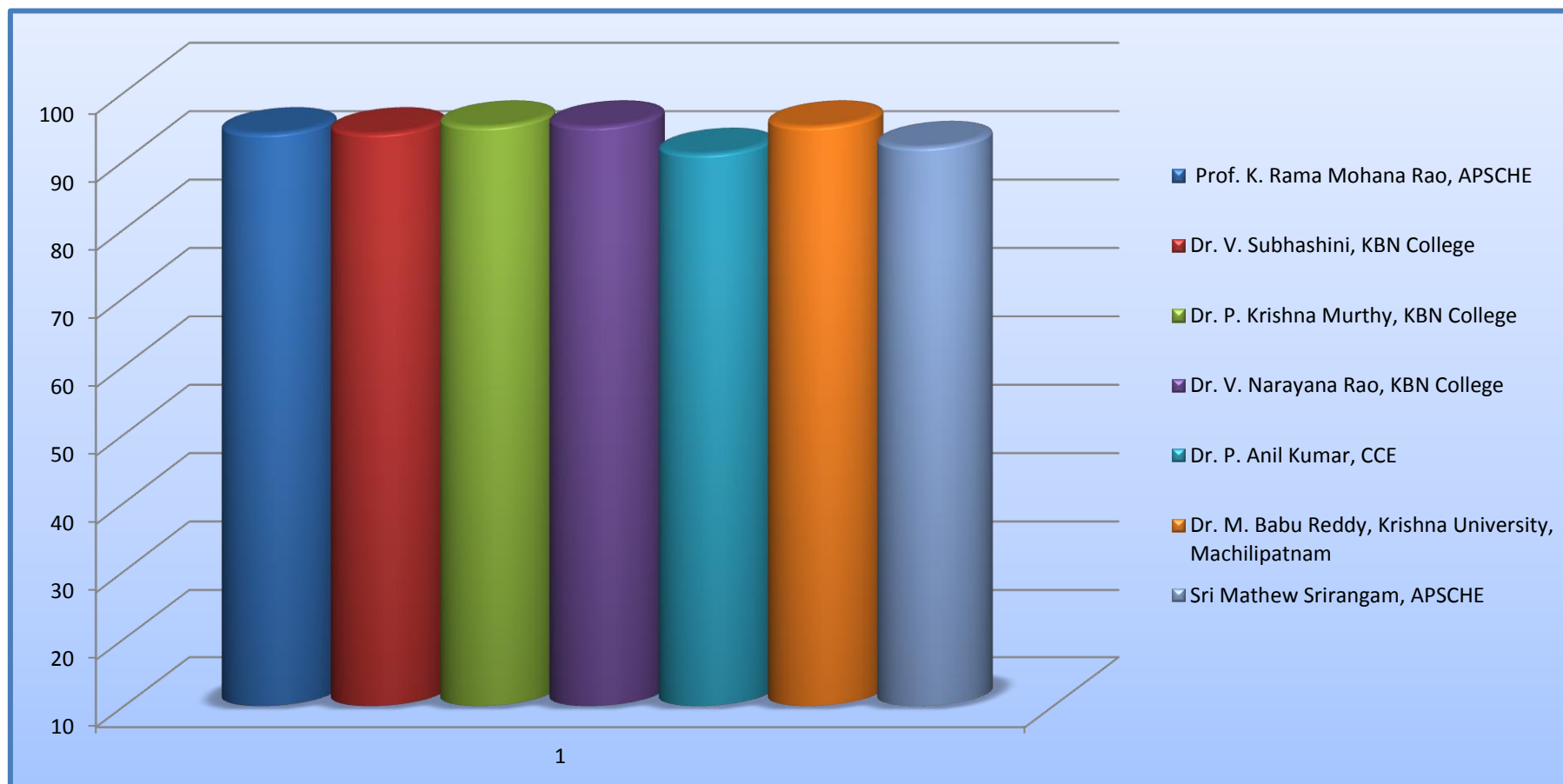
