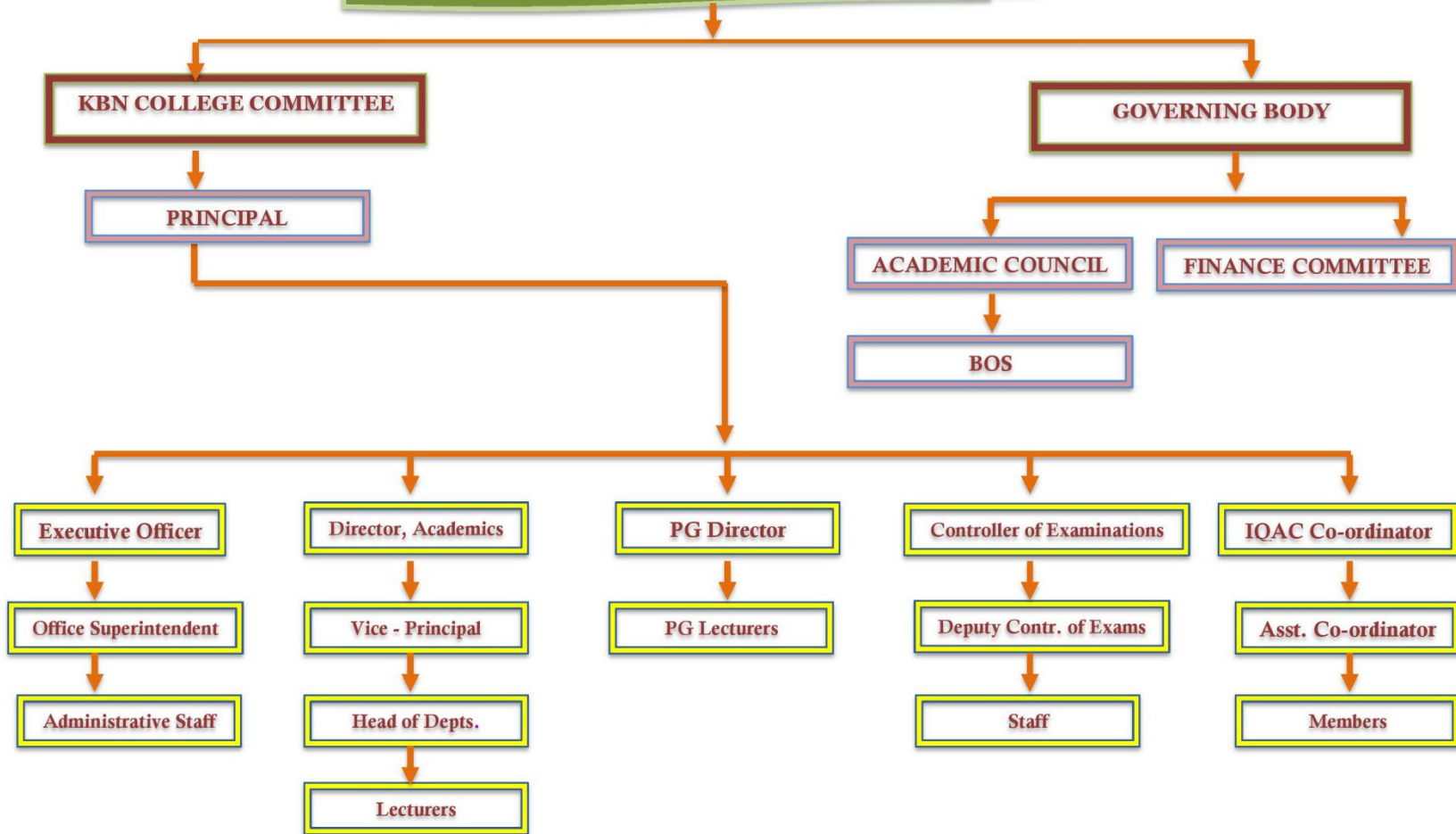

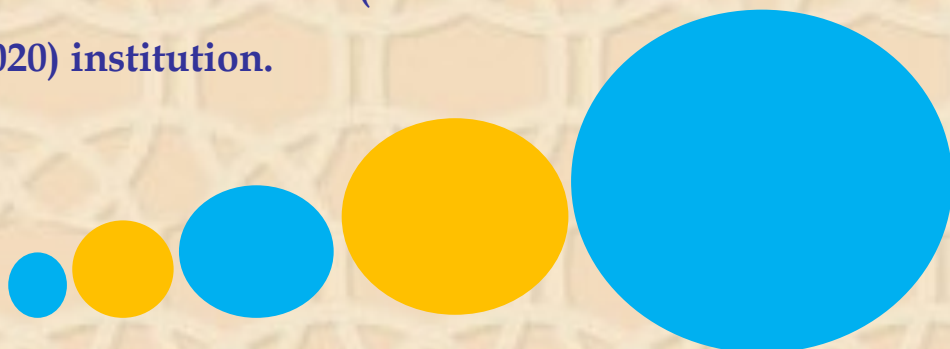

It is one of the pioneering educational institutions in Vijayawada run with the motto 'TEJASWINA VADHITAMASTU' which means 'May our Study be Enlightening'. The college is known for its perseverance to academic excellence and value-based holistic education. Comprehensive education attained by students of the college enables them to participate in developmental and transformative activities for the benefit of the community and the society at large. The College firmly believes in the maxim that service to Man is service to God, especially with regard to education, which is truly the pathway for enlightenment.



The foundation stone for this citadel of higher learning was laid on **6th November 1964** by Sri Kasu Brahmanada Reddy, the then Honourable Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh. Named after the founder Danaseela Pura-pramukha and Vidya-Poshaka **Sri Kakaraparti Bhavanarayana Shreshty**, the college is illuminating the lives of many communities that were otherwise socially ostracized in the bygone years. 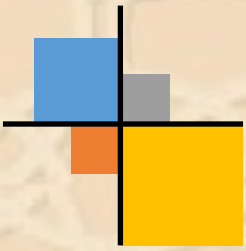

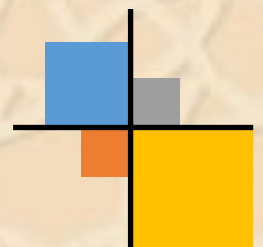

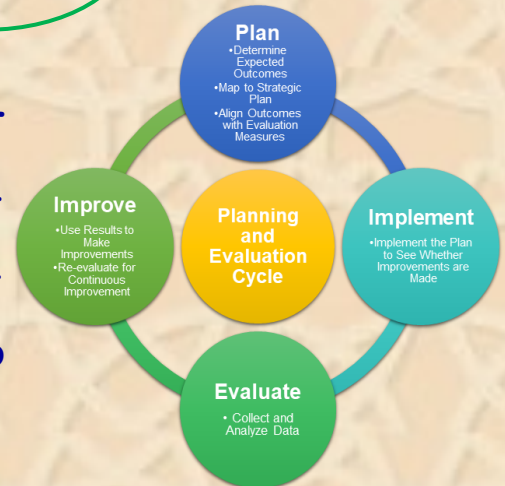
