She addressed the students on “Scope of Zoology in Higher Education and Career Opportunities”. She explained that students after completing their PG Course can settle down as an Assistant Professor or pursue their doctorate degree. They can take different competitive exams like NET organized by CSIR, UGC, DBT, TIFR etc. one can also join in reputed pharma companies or scientific labs like CCMB, Dr. Reddy’s lab, Devis lab etc. She said that in addition to the option of being a Scientist they can become an Ecologist, Forest Conservation Officer, Environmental Education Officer, Toxicologist, Aquaculturist in MPEDA etc.

In addition to normal M.Sc. they can choose Dairy Science, Sericulture, Poultry, Veterinary Science as their future careers which also helps them to establish their own farms under self-employment. She also gave a gist of courses prevailing in different Universities. She stressed the importance of JAM (Joint Admission into Master of Science) for the entry of Life Sciences students into IIT’S. She gave information about the APPSC Examination.
