- Outcome based Education helps Higher Education Institutions to analyze, assess and map the lesson learnt by students based on the questions attempted to attain Programme Outcomes (POs), Course Outcomes (Cos) and Programme Education Objectives (PEOd).
- To create awareness among faculty members about Outcome-Based Education System.

The programme was started by inviting the dignitaries by Dr. G. Krishnaveni, IQAC Coordinator, and the programme was inaugurated by opening remarks of the Principal Dr. V. Narayana Rao.


